

## Covid 19 Club Rules for Sailing Issue 4 (14<sup>th</sup> Sep 2020)

1. 2-meter distancing rules to be always maintained
2. A maximum of SIX people in the compound including Officer of the Day.
3. 1 committee member to be in charge at each meeting
4. 1 table per person
5. All tables to be 2.5 meters from the fence
6. All tables 0.5 meter apart
7. The stairs and landing stage to be **kept clear at all times** except when launching and recovering boats
8. Points for sailing boats will be marked out on the day of sailing. These will be by the steps and in the compound
9. In the grass area there will be a ground marker 2 meters from the fence to distance the public
10. Full members only, no family in compound
11. All members to bring the NEW photo membership cards. These will be made available to Members on their first day of sailing under these rules.
12. Please do not enter the compound until the Officer of the Day is in attendance
13. Please help the Officer of the Day put out and put away on the day
14. Please bring your own disposable gloves and mask if required

Lightweight tables to be used rather than wooden tables.

Ancillary Equipment to be first aid, waders, life-belt and pole

Tea will not be available on sailing days.

### **Sailing Day Booking System**

Please book with the Club Secretary if you are interested in sailing at a particular sailing session. Bookings for the required session may be made as follows: - Please book with the Secretary between six days and two days before the required sailing date. A selection of 5 successful applicants will be made, giving priority to Members who have not recently attended a sailing day. Two days before the sailing date the Secretary will inform the applicants of the result of the selection process.

**Do not turn up without booking as you will be turned away.**

If you cannot turn up on the day, please inform the Club Secretary ASAP.

THERE WILL BE 6 PERSONS ONLY ALLOWED IN THE COMPOUND. THIS INCLUDES 1 COMMITTEE MEMBER.

**The Committee member will be officer of the day and his decision is final.**

Disabled parking will be in effect as usual, but drop off and pickups should park on the grass behind the disabled area, then return to the carpark

Sailing will be 10am till 12noon for daytime sailings and 6pm till 8pm should we be able to arrange an evening session. This of course is dependent on time of year.

**The club will endeavour to have disposable gloves and hand sanitiser on hand.**

### Now the Council bit

Please be aware the council own the lake, and as such can ask the club to STOP sailing at any time. Also, the police at present have the same right.

The Council and Club also accept no responsibility for you sailing at any session. This is a totally personal choice.
